Approximately 650 people received H1N1 immunizations Wednesday during a clinic conducted by the Logan County Health District at the Discovery Center, 1973 W. State Route 47.

The targeted group for the clinic was primary caregivers of infants younger than age 6 months and Discovery Center children.
