

## Child Immunization Clinic Price List: Effective 01/11/2012

The Federal Government supplies vaccine for those children (18 years old and younger) who qualify for the **Vaccine for Children (VFC)** program. To qualify: a child must be on Medicaid, Alaskan/American Indian, have no insurance or be under insured. The Ohio Department of Health (ODH) also supplies some additional vaccines. When using VFC or State-supplied vaccine, only an administration fee will be charged. This fee is **\$15.00 per injection**. All other vaccines are purchased by the health district and fees are set to cover the cost of the vaccine. **No Child will be denied these vaccines for failure to pay, except for**

**\*\*\*Rotavirus, Gardasil and Hepatitis A (vaccines not provided through ODH).** These are 2 tiered pricing  
We have a waiting list to purchase the above vaccines\*\*\* for self pay patients.
